The highlight of the day happens at 5:00 pm when of hundreds of carved and lighted pumpkins set the Green aglow.

4:30 - 7:30: Horse drawn hayrides take riders around the Village.

5:00 - 7:00: Cookie decorating at the Child and Family Services table.

5:00-7:30: Take a spooky walk through the "haunted" Ivoryton Library, enjoy live music by "Federation", and try the free refreshments (while they last) provided by the Lions Club, All Saints Episcopal Church and Essex Park and Rec.
